

Covid-19 Vaccine Information

The Georgia Department of Public Health is currently administering COVID-19 vaccine in Phase 1a+ which includes:

- Healthcare workers (physicians, nurses, laboratory technicians, EMS personnel, environmental services, etc.)
- Residents and staff of long-term care facilities
- Adults aged 65+ and their caregivers
- Law enforcement, firefighters, first responders

Vaccine supply is very limited. Public health departments are scheduling vaccines by appointment only, as are most other providers. Depending on vaccine supply allocations from the federal government, it may be weeks before additional providers will have vaccine available for quicker and more widespread distribution.

This information changes frequently, especially the availability of specific vaccines. Also, there may be some duplications below, but there are different ways to reach these sites. Bring your confirmation, driver's license, and insurance card when you go to the vaccine location. If you get onto a site online, print every page that has your name on it in case you get closed out before the final verification page. Also, if you can get your name on an email for any of the below sites, you might hear back from them.

An Atlanta entrepreneur has launched a free text messaging service to help you know when new appointments for the COVID-19 vaccine are loaded on to a county's website. Simply text VAX to 678-679-0250, then answer questions via text about your county. The app continuously checks several County Health Departments and as soon as a county opens registration, it sends you a text to let you know. As of Jan. 22, this app worked for Clayton, Cobb, DeKalb, Douglas, Fulton, Newton and Rockdale counties with plans to add more. However, you may still encounter difficulties accessing county websites to sign up. Simply text VAX to 678-679-0250 or 844-554-4024

Directions to Mercedes Benz Stadium via Waze and information once you arrive. You want to park in the Silver Parking Deck. Once you arrive in the Silver Parking Deck, signs will direct you to the correct level depending on whether you are receiving Dose 1 or Dose 2 of the Covid-19 vaccine.
